## **Brussels Sprouts, Darkmar**



## **Description**

The sprouts are green, sweet, and firm, and harvesting is a cinch; the heads snap off easily with a bit of pressure. Darkmar is nutty, sweet, and fabulous browned in the oven.

## **Planting Instructions**

- Start Brussels Sprout seeds indoors 3/15 at 72-85°.
- Days to germination: 5-8.

<ul> <li>Transplant outside 4/15, spaced 18" apart in rows 24" apart.</li> <li>Protect Brussels Sprout plants from deer, groundhogs, and rabbits.</li> <li>Cabbage plants may be eaten by several different species of caterpillars. If they cause damage, hand remove caterpillars or spray organic BT.</li> </ul>
