## Artichoke, Green Globe



### Description

a large, hardy perennial plant growing 3 to 4 feet tall and spreading 4 feet wide. It produces globe-shaped flower heads about 4 to 6 inches in diameter. The tender, fleshy base of the leaves and the heart are edible and prized for their nutty, slightly sweet flavor. Perfect for steaming, grilling, or stuffing, Green Globe artichokes add both garden beauty and delicious harvest to any home grower's collection.

### Planting Instructions

- Sow seeds indoors 1/2" deep about 8-12 weeks before last frost.
- Wait to transplant outdoors until soil is warm.
- Plant 48" Apart
- Full sun
- 120 days until maturity
- Harvest when bud is firm, tight and about 3 to 5" in diameter
